

## NICK MANCUSO SECURES 2<sup>nd</sup> PLACE PIRELLI WORLD CHALLENGE FINISH AT THE ST. PETERSBURG GRAND PRIX ON DEBUT DRIVE FOR FERRARI



St. Petersburg Grand Prix / St. Petersburg, FL (March 31, 2014) – After having spent the past several years in racecars that have widely varied from open wheel IndyCar-type cars to front wheel drive turbos, it appears that racecar driver Nick Mancuso has finally found his home with the marque that he has grown up with: *Ferrari*. Driving the #16 Ferrari Lake Forest entry prepared by R. Ferri Motorsports, Mancuso fought his way up the grid from 6<sup>th</sup> place to finish on the podium in 2<sup>nd</sup> position in the GTA class of Pirelli World Challenge.

Running in conjunction with IndyCar at the Cadillac Grand Prix of St. Petersburg, the Pirelli World Challenge (PWC) series began its 25<sup>th</sup> year of competition with 50+ racecars taking to the streets of St. Pete. With PWC opening up the rules for 2014 to allow the addition of full-blown GT3 cars from Europe, the exotic car manufacturers showed up in full force. With entries from Ferrari, Lamborghini, McLaren, Audi, Mercedes, Porsche, and many others, the stage was set for an all-out street fight.

Mancuso, a newcomer to the exceedingly quick GT3 machinery, acquitted himself rather well from the start qualifying 6<sup>th</sup> and posting a 1:14.686 laptime; the exact same (down to the

thousandth of a second) as defending series champion Johnny O'Connell in 5<sup>th</sup>. "I was actually a bit disappointed in qualifying, but that's just the racer in me," stated Mancuso. "I had to take a step back, look at the names of the guys around me and say 'ok...not a bad start!'" Speaking of starts, the PWC series features a unique, Formula 1-style standing start that had the whole Ferrari camp a bit apprehensive. "Some of the cars around me have pretty fancy launch control systems. As trick as the 458 GT3 is we had to do our start the old-fashioned way; my launch control was my left and right feet!"

Nick managed to get the start quite right and was in 3<sup>rd</sup> place by Turn 1. He proceeded to have lengthy, door-to-door battles with the Lamborghinis and Audis around him. While matching the laptimes of his more experienced teammate Anthony Lazzaro, Nick worked his way up to a 2<sup>nd</sup> place result when the checkered flag flew. "I have to say a huge thank you to the R. Ferri Motorsports guys. They truly worked tirelessly; even staying at the track until 2am one night and showing up at 6 the next morning. These guys are as hungry to win as I am so I know there will be good things to come this year. This Ferrari 458 worked flawlessly the whole weekend and we're only getting faster."

Next for the #16 Ferrari Lake Forest entry is the Toyota Grand Prix of Long Beach April 10-13<sup>th</sup>.
